Finally, bottling day will arrive, where - you guessed it - you will be able to fill and cap your beer in 22-ounce bottles. Your brew will be ready to enjoy on the day you take it home, so give your bottles as personalized gifts or pass them around at your holiday party.

Eudora Brewing Co., Ohio

Eudora also offers a brew-your-own experience, with professional staff on hand to supervise you as your concoct your beverage creation and help you, as needed. Brewing takes two to four weeks, so plan ahead in order to have your brew ready for the holidays.

The brewery offers different recipes for standard, premium and signature series bottles, and sells them in five-gallon (two cases of 12-ounce bottles) and 10-gallon (four cases of 12-ounce bottles) batches.
